English

This week our English work is going to be connected to our trip to Hunstanton. On Tuesday the children will be thinking about the possible dangers of going on a trip to Hunstanton and writing a letter to Mr Cooper to convince that they will be safe. On Thursday the children will be writing about their trip to Hunstanton. Before going to Hunstanton the children will be reading about Henry Le Strange, the man who developed the town of Hunstanton. There are going to be a mixture of different spellings this:
 Red spellings = key words
 Orange spellings = contractions
 Green spellings = using 's' on the end of words, but knowing whether that 's' is used to make a word plural or as a possessive apostrophe.

Maths

Homework: Reading scales
Throughout the week: Finishing off work on measurement by working on length and the units of measurement connected with length - mm, cm, m and km. Then moving onto solving missing number problems eg $21 + ? = 36$
Miss Kyndt and Mrs Kansu's groups:
Homework: Subtraction
Throughout the week: Solving missing number problems eg $21 + ? = 36$
Mrs Bethke's group
Homework: Number fact families/inverse operations eg $7 + 4 = 11$, so $11 - 4 = 7$
Throughout the week: Doubles and halves up to 20.
